Resolution Re: Unsafe and Dangerous Structure Located at 192 Tanglewylde Road, Putnam Valley, New York - Tax Parcels: 83.50-1-10 and 83.50-1-14

A Resolution having been issued by the Town Board on August 17, 2016 directing filing and service of a Notice of Unsafe and Dangerous Structure at 192 Tanglewylde Road, Putnam Valley, New York – Tax Parcels: 83.50-1-10 and 83.50-1-14; and such Notice having been executed by the Supervisor of the Town of Putnam Valley on August 18, 2016 and such Notice having been filed with the Clerk of Putnam County on August 30, 2016 and served upon the owner and any person having a vested or contingent interest in such unsafe building as evidenced by the Affidavits of Service annexed hereto; and a hearing having been held on September 21, 2016 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall located at 265 Oscawana Lake Road, Putnam Valley, New York 10579; and no one having appeared in opposition to the aforesaid Notice of Unsafe and Dangerous Structure or the orders contained therein; and the demolition and removal of such building and debris, backfilling and seeding not having commenced within thirty (30) days of the service of said Notice as evidenced by the Certification of the Town Of Putnam Valley Code Enforcement Officer dated October 5, 2016, a copy of which is attached,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the aforesaid demolition and removal, backfilling and seeding of the unsafe structure located at 192 Tanglewylde Road be undertaken by the Town of Putnam Valley with all deliberate speed in accordance with the provisions of Section 66-9 of the Town Code of Putnam Valley and the Town Supervisor and/or the Code Enforcement Officer is hereby authorized to solicit competitive bids for such demolition and removal and award an appropriate Contract for same subject to approval of the Town Board; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with Town Code Section 66-10 all expenses incurred by the Town in connection with the proceedings to repair and secure or demolish and remove the unsafe building, including the cost of actually removing such building, shall be assessed against the land on which such building is located and shall be levied and collected in the same manner as provided in Article 15 of the Town Law of the State of New York for the levy and collection of a special ad valorent levy.
